

**Tennessee Technology Center at Covington  
2009 Practical Nursing Education Information**

**What types of classes are available?**

**Full-time Day program** – This class is 12 months in length and meets Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. (clinical times may vary). Our next day class will begin in September 2009.

**Part-time Evening/Weekend program** - This class is 18 months in length and meets Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday evenings from 5 to 9 pm and 8 hours on Saturday (clinical times may vary). Our next evening/weekend class will begin in May 2010. Please note there may be a change in the entrance exam. An implementation date for the new assessment test is yet to be determined.

**When is the entrance exam given?**

All of the NET dates for the September Day 2009 program have passed or are full. If you can take the NET at another Tennessee Technology Center, we will accept scores through April 8, 2009, for our September Day 2009 class.

We will release more information about our May Evening/Weekend 2010 class and the new entrance exam on July 1, 2009.

**Application Process**

Once you have passed the entrance exam, you will complete an Admissions Application and receive a letter regarding the next step in the application process. Students are required to pass the entrance exam by the deadline, attend the orientation session, complete paperwork by the deadline, and interview before their file is submitted to a committee. The committee will review all eligible applicants and select the class. Please note: passing the entrance exam does not guarantee admittance.

**What if I have already taken the NET and Passed?**

If you have taken the NET test previously at this Center, you must come to TTC-Covington and submit a NEW Admissions Application, so that we can pull your scores. Please be sure to indicate on the Admissions Application that you tested here previously. If you tested at another Tennessee Technology Center, you must have the official scores mailed to TTC-Covington from the testing center and come to TTC-Covington and complete an Admissions Application. NET scores must come from the other TTC to be considered official – we do not accept a student copy. Please be sure to indicate that you tested at another center on your Admissions Application. Please note: there may be an additional charge if the test from another institution is incomplete.

**What date must TTC-Covington receive my NET scores?**

In order to be considered for our Day September 2009 class, we must have your NET scores by close of business on **Wednesday, April 8, 2009.**

In order to be considered for our Evening/Weekend May 2010 class, we must have your NET scores by close of business on **Wednesday, December 9, 2009.**

**What NET dates are valid for the program?**

NET scores must be within two years of the class starting. Only NET scores taken after September 1, 2007, will be eligible for the September 2009 Day Class. Only NET scores taken after May 1, 2008, will be eligible for the May 2010 Evening/Weekend Class.
